The 2014 presentations will have a distinct Garden State flavor, with the New Jersey PGA section receiving our Distinguished Service Award and Knickerbocker CC, Tenafly, NJ, which will be celebrating its centennial season, getting our Club of the Year award. Winner of the New York City Amateur, Mittelmark and Nassau Invitationals, the Arcola Cup, and part of the victorious duo in the Anderson Memorial, Buckley's first pro event will be the Met Open Aug. 19-21 at Trump National-Bedminster. The 23-year-old from Rye, NY, who will continue to compete as an amateur for half of next season, also was second at the Ike and third in the Westchester Open . . . **Mike Ballo Jr**. of Stamford, CT, **Sunny Kim** of Palm Beach Gardens, FL, and **Chris Scialo** of New York, NY, all came up short of the top 46 finishers in the six-round Final Stage qualifying Dec. 12-17 for the 2014 Web.com Tour season. Ballo is winner of the 2009-10 Ike championships; Kim won the 2004 MGA/Met Life Boys title; and Scialo is a past winner of the Brae Burn Invitational and Arcola Cup . . .

# **GREAT EXPECTATIONS CAPTURES TEAM SHOOTOUT**

Our final gathering of the 2013 season took place this fall at Metropolis CC, Greenburgh, NY, with more than 50 attendees. The club and its staff, under the supervision of general manager **Tracy Fraus**, was supremely gracious. Our gathering was treated to wonderful clubhouse amenities, superb food & beverage, and a very challenging golf course.

Founded in 1922, the club's original course was designed by golf pro/architect **Herbert Strong**, with subsequent expansion and renovation by **A.W. Tillinghast**, **Joe Finger** and **Ken Dye**. The layout is currently undergoing a substantial upgrade, including considerable restructuring on a variety of green complexes and the removal of hundreds of trees. Architect **Ron Force** is supervising the current course project.

"With the competition for membership in this area, for clubs to stay viable, keep existing members and attract new members, you have to put your best foot forward, which is your golf course," Metropolis president **Barry Winograd** conveyed to our MGWA attendees. "Our Board approved a broad master plan, which will also feature improvements to our first-class tennis facilities, our buildings and all of our grounds."

The annual MGWA Team Shootout, with its two net best balls of foursome format, served as our final competition for the season. The team called Great Expectations, comprised of **Paul Lieberman**, **Jon Peisinger**, **Drew Greenland** and **Bill Fullard**, narrowly won the title at 16-under par. Second place at 15-under, on a match of cards, went to the Mixed Media foursome of **Adam Balkin**, **Steve Paulus**, **Jane Dally** and **Sarah Lane**. Finishing third were the Berger Kings, who had won the event the previous three seasons: **Dan Berger**, **Jon Olson**, **Eric Berger**, **Joe Ruggiero**. Nearest to the pin winners were **Ralph Wimbish** and **Doug Goodman**.
